# CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

## Pre-K to 1st Grade

- Exposure to Hebrew letters, usage of which is practiced and reinforced through reading exercises and application of vocabulary & phrases

## 2nd to 3rd Grade

- Lifecycle events
- Blessings and prayers
- Familiarization with Jewish symbols, holidays and culture
- Exposure to Hebrew letters, usage of which is further practiced and reinforced through reading exercises and application of vocabulary & phrases

## 4th Grade

- Customs and values associated with each Jewish holiday.
- Decoding Hebrew
- Reciting prayers during congregational services; understanding the roots of prayer phrases & vocabulary
